The Gilstad Literacy Foundation Board of Directors is pleased to announce Gaylin Morris has accepted their invitation to become Executive Director of the Foundation to succeed retiring Executive Director, Dr. Christine Zimmer.

Mrs. Morris is a multi-generational Charlotte Countian and professional educator who is passionate about literacy and lifelong learning, community partnerships, and empowering parents to nurture their young children so they can learn to love reading. She holds degrees and certifications from Manatee Junior College, Barry University, Edison Community College Educator Preparation Institute, and multiple Florida Professional Educator Certifications. During her tenure with Charlotte County Public Schools, Gaylin taught and held leadership roles at elementary and middle schools and served as the District Curriculum and Instructional Specialist for K-12 Science and STEM. Her community involvement includes volunteering with Virginia B. Andes Clinic, Girls on the Run, American Cancer Society/Relay for Life, Hibiscus Festival, and Military Heritage Museum STEM Camps. She is a 2001 graduate of the Leadership Charlotte class of the Charlotte County Chamber of Commerce.
